



## NOTICE OF DELAY IN THE DELIVERY OF INFORMATION

**Mexico City, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Sitios Latinoamérica, S.A.B. de C.V. (“Sitios”) [BMV: LASITE]**, in relation to the disclosure of relevant information to be presented to the National Banking and Securities Commission, the Mexican Stock Exchange, and the public, as referred to in Article 104 of the Securities Market Law, as well as the annual information referred to in Article 33, fraction I of the General Provisions Applicable to Issuers of Securities and other Participants in the Securities Market (the “CUE”), Sitios hereby informs the public that it is unable to disclose the aforementioned information given that the external audit review process, conducted by Mancera, S.C. / E&Y Mexico, of the financial statements as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 is still ongoing, regarding the accounting calculations of IFRS16 (International Financial Reporting Standard). In accordance with Article 45 of the CUE, Sitios will present said information within 20 (twenty) business days following April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
